Hosting a North U Racing Rules Seminar at Your Club

You can host a Racing Rules Seminar at your club. You can choose either a full day or evening program. A complete course description follows below.

You pay a flat fee for us to provide the seminar leader and course. In addition, you are responsible for instructor travel expenses, meals and lodging. There is an additional charge for Rules Seminar Workbooks. You can offer other North U books and CDs for sale if you like. You pay only for the materials you use and can return any unused materials.

Marketing

You are responsible for marketing and promoting your event as well as handling registrations. We will provide course descriptions and outlines that you can use in your publicity.

We will also provide posters and E-vites. You can charge whatever tuition you like.

Site Requirements

We'll need the following at the seminar location:

- € Classroom style set up, with tables and chairs (participants like to take notes).
- € LARGE screen, preferably 8x8 or as close to these dimensions as possible
- € Control over lighting (too many windows and no window coverings will present a problem).

The room needs to be dark enough to see our presentation. Don't forget, the sun is out during the day.

- € Projection table with power. (We bring our own projector and computer. Backups are welcome.)
- € MAGNETIC white board or black board. (Must be *magnetic* for model boats.)
- € Registration table.
- € Catering for breaks and lunch.
- € Detailed directions, ample parking.
- € Housing and Local Transportation for the Instructor.

Cost

Instructor and Course Fees: Pricing starts at \$1800 for a one day seminar or \$1000 for an evening seminar. Fees are higher for some instructors.

Expenses: Host is also responsible for instructor travel, meals, and accommodations.

In addition, there is a \$6 per student fee for the course workbook.

Additional North U books and CDs are available at a discount:

Unused books and CDs can be returned.

These fees are in addition to your local expenses - for marketing/mailing, catering, room set up and equipment, if any.
